Did you know that Columbia City has an estimated 2,212 dogs? An average sized dog can drop about ¾ pounds of waste every day. That's 1,659 pounds or almost 1TON of dog waste generated in Columbia City every day! When it rains, bacteria from pet waste can wash directly into storm drains and drainage ditches and eventually into our waterways completely untreated. Do your part in properly disposing of pet waste for cleaner water in our community!
